Deadline January 21, 2024

All abstracts for oral or poster presentations are to be submitted online and in English only no later than January 21, 2024 via www.csrs-europe-congress.com. Authors will be notified of the acceptance of their abstract by email by the end of February 2024. In order to include an abstract in the scientific program, the presenting author is required to register for the congress and pay the registration fee as soon as the notification of abstract acceptance is received, but no later than two weeks upon receipt. 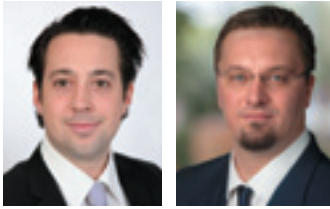
